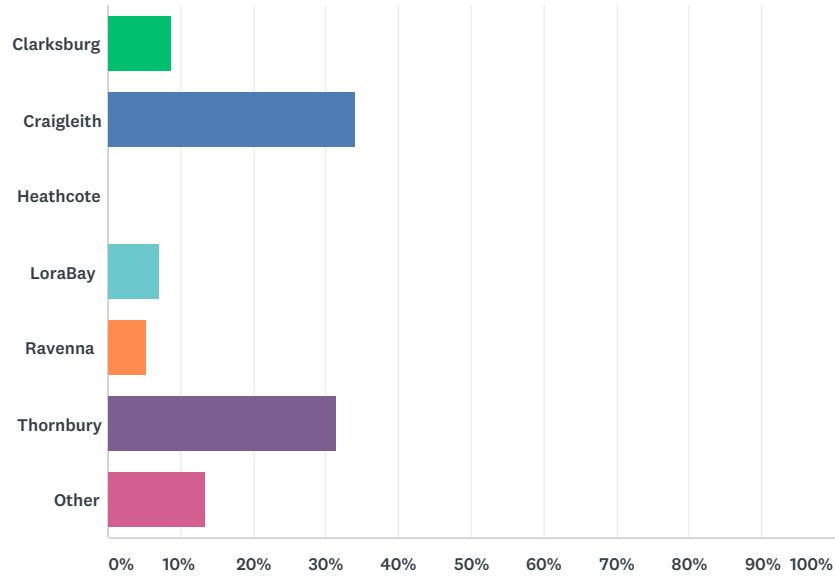


Q1 Where in the Town of Blue Mountains do you reside?

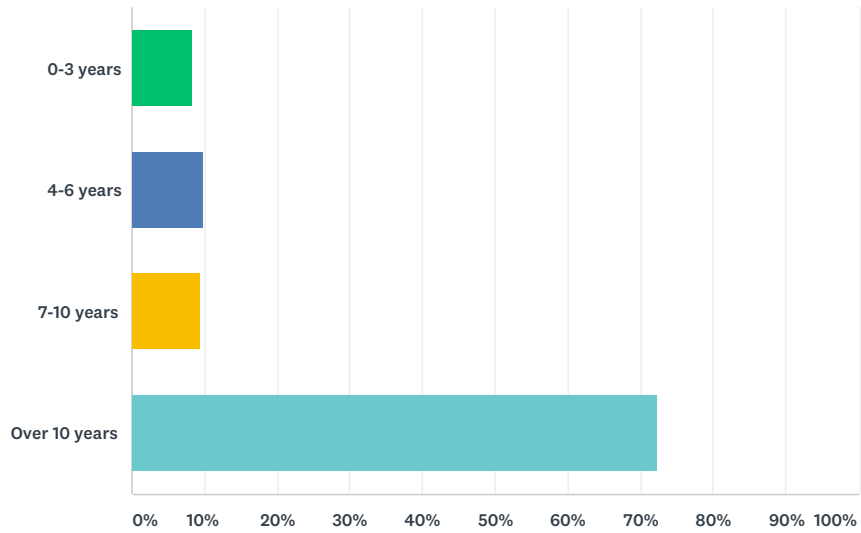

Q2 How long have you resided in the TBM?

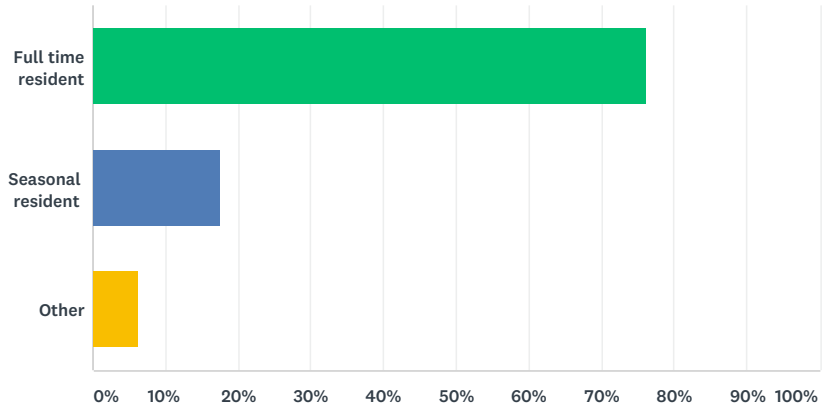

Q3 Do you consider yourself a...

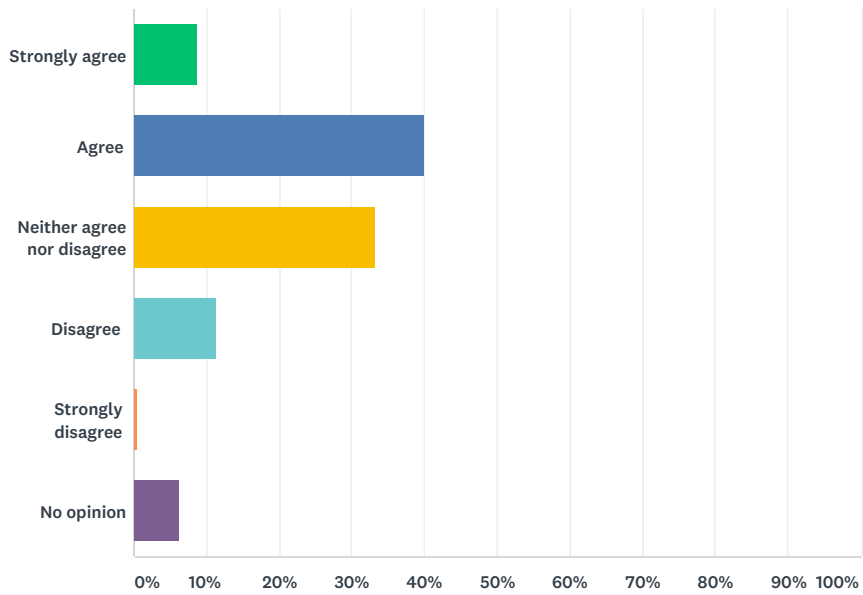

Q4 I am happy with the way Town Council is handling business to this point in time?

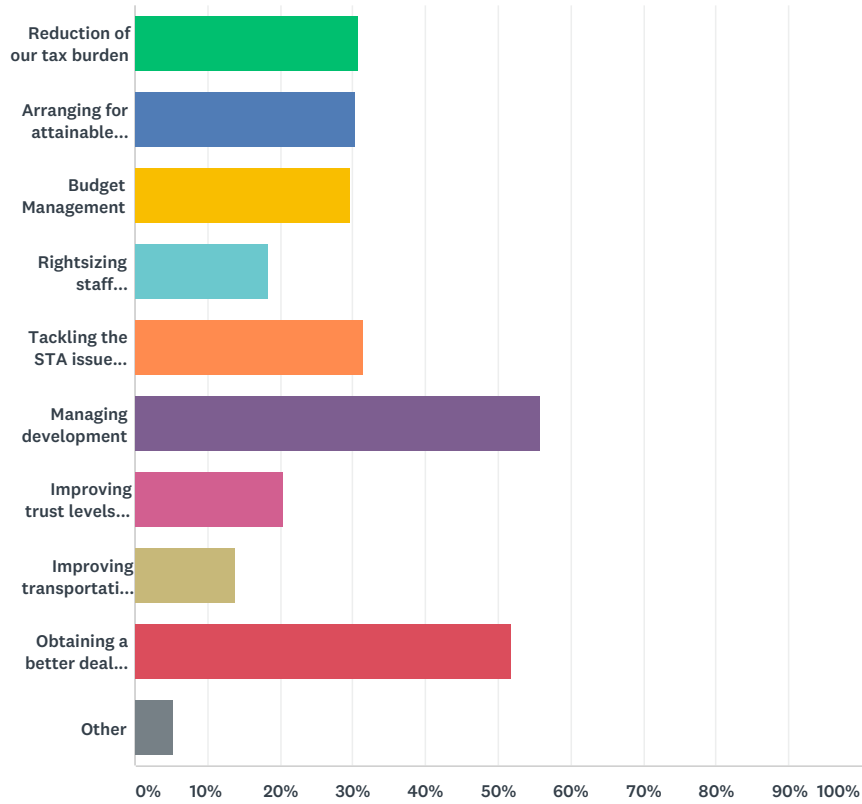

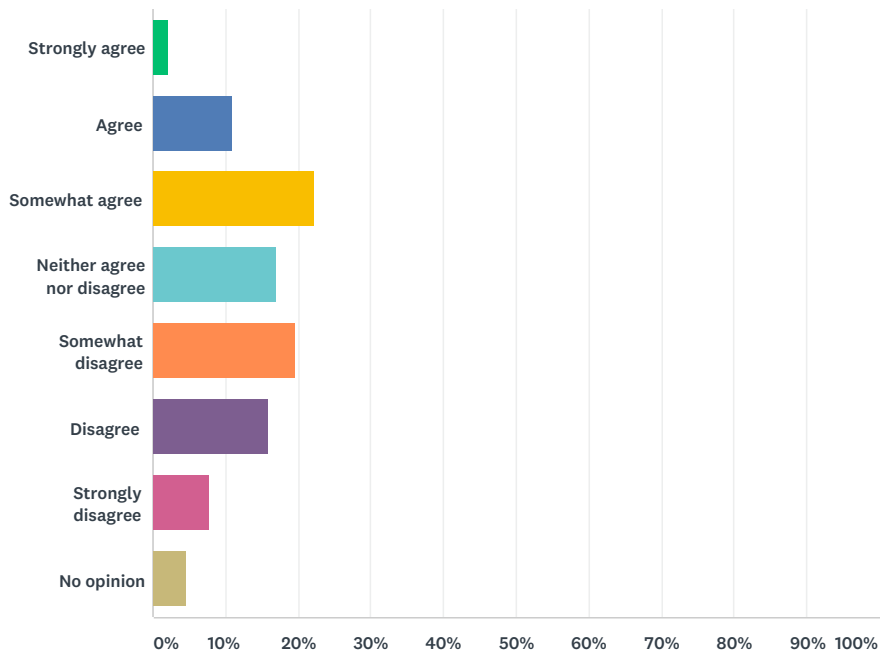

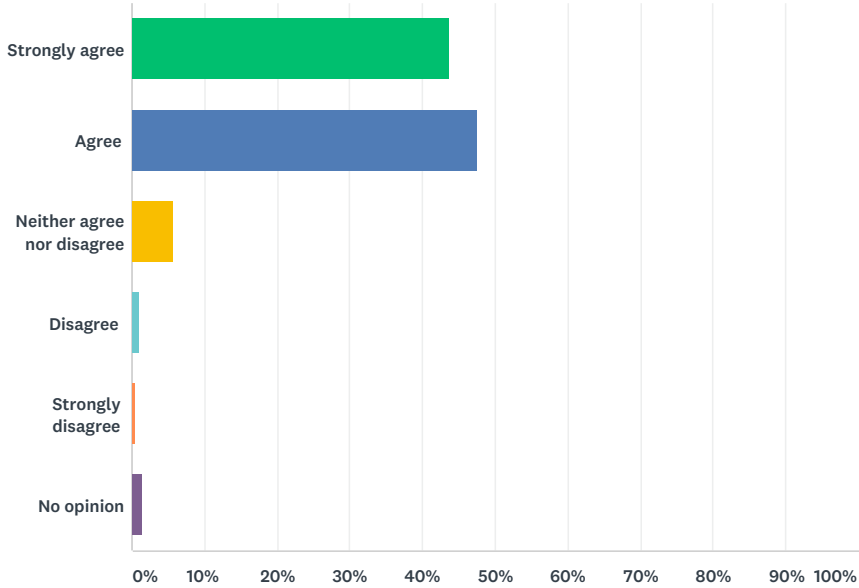

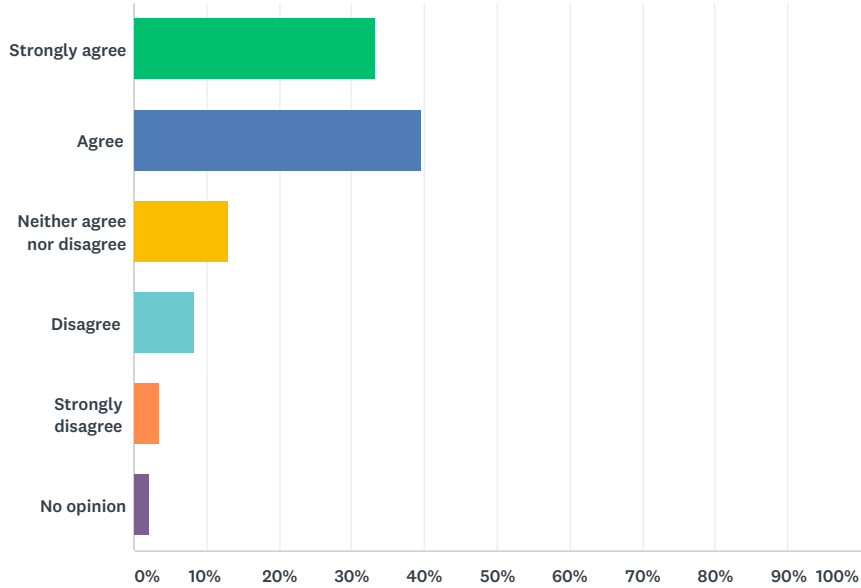

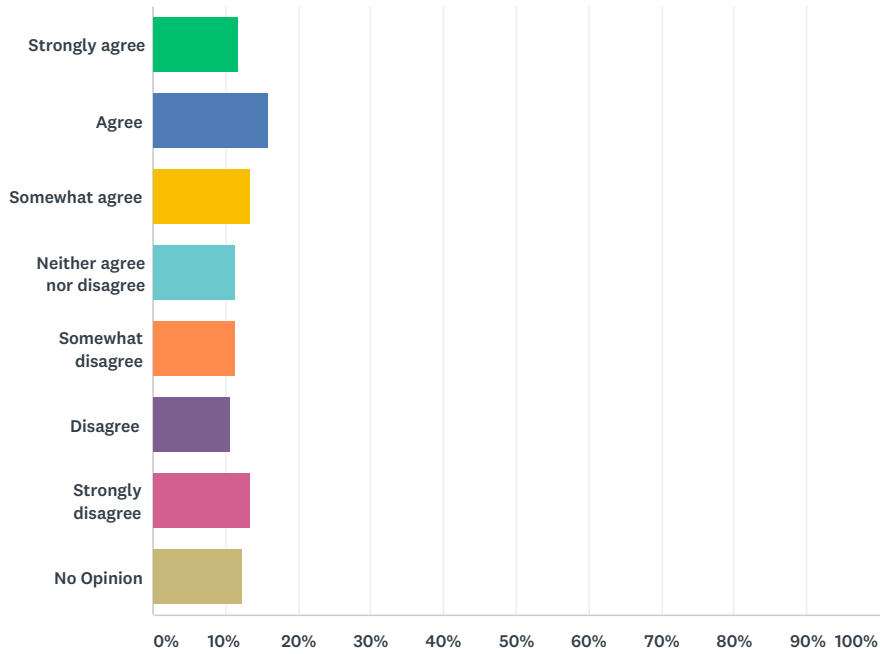

Q9 Short term accommodations are managed responsibly and the owners held sufficiently accountable for noise and other nuisances caused by their renters.

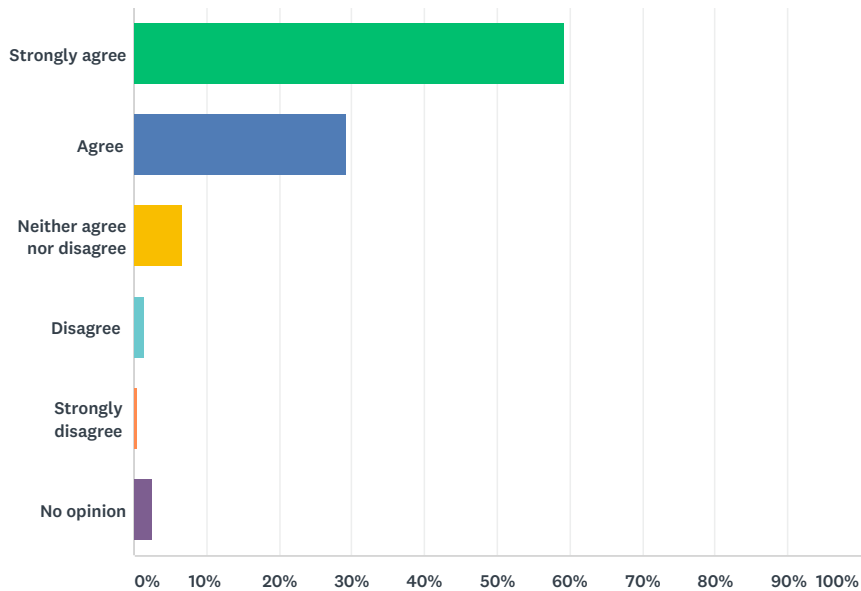

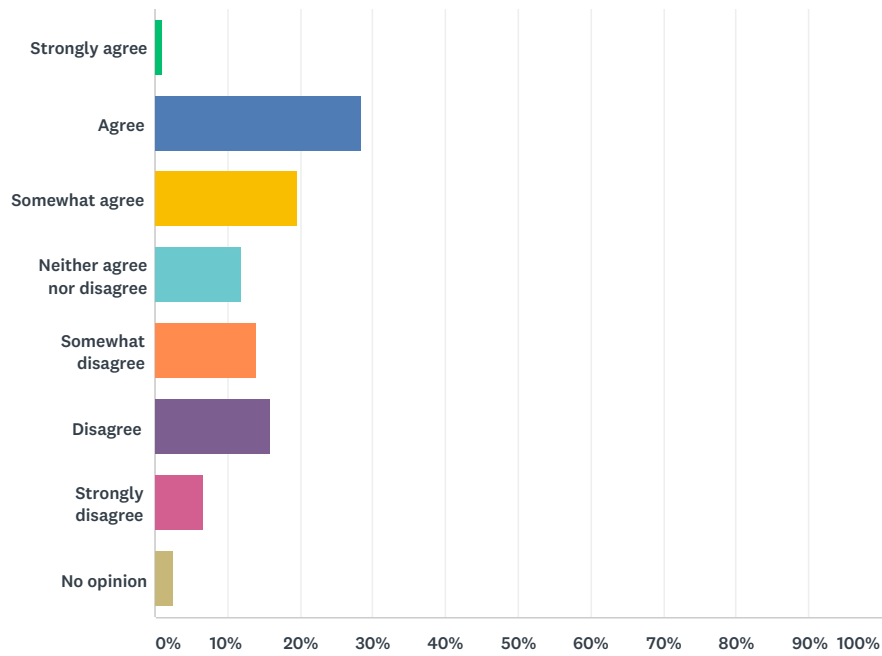

Q11 The Town increase in taxes for 2019 is 3% - this is a reasonable amount

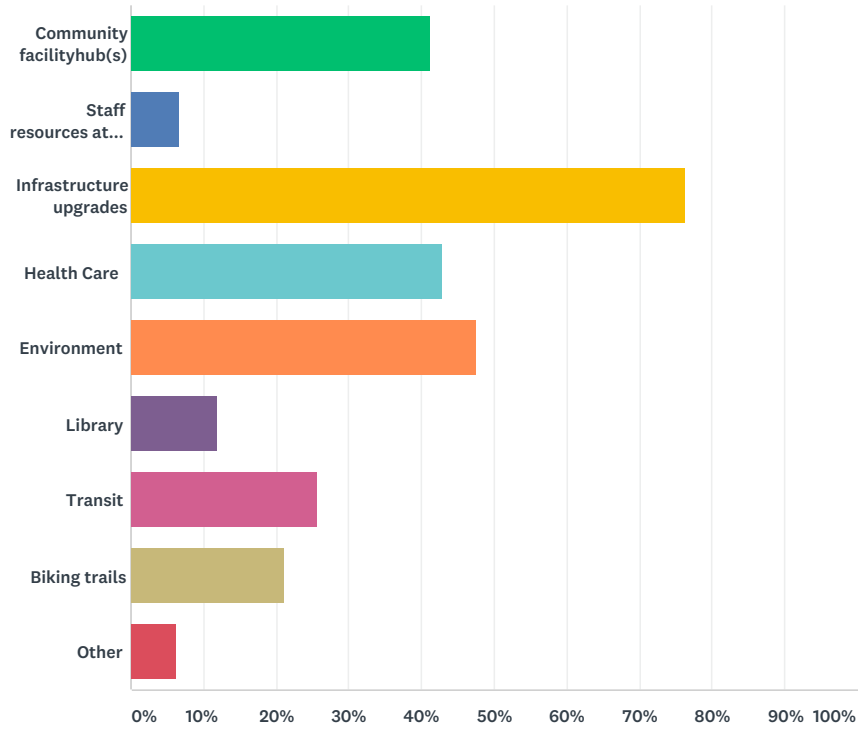

Q12 Where would you like to see your tax money being spent (pick three)

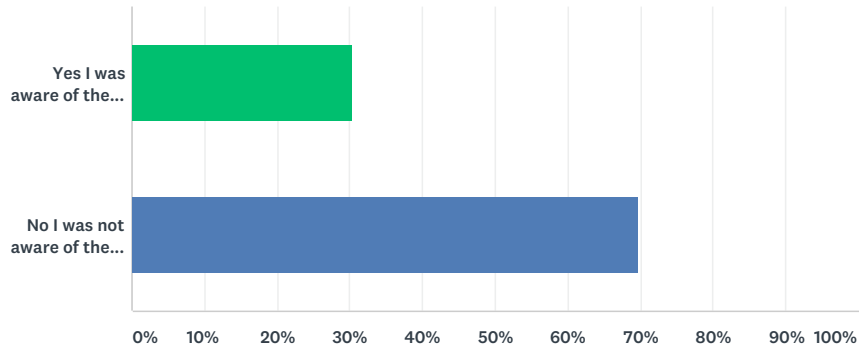

Q13 I am aware of the significant capital costs, in the range of \$20 million, associated with water-related infrastructure projects coming in the next couple of years

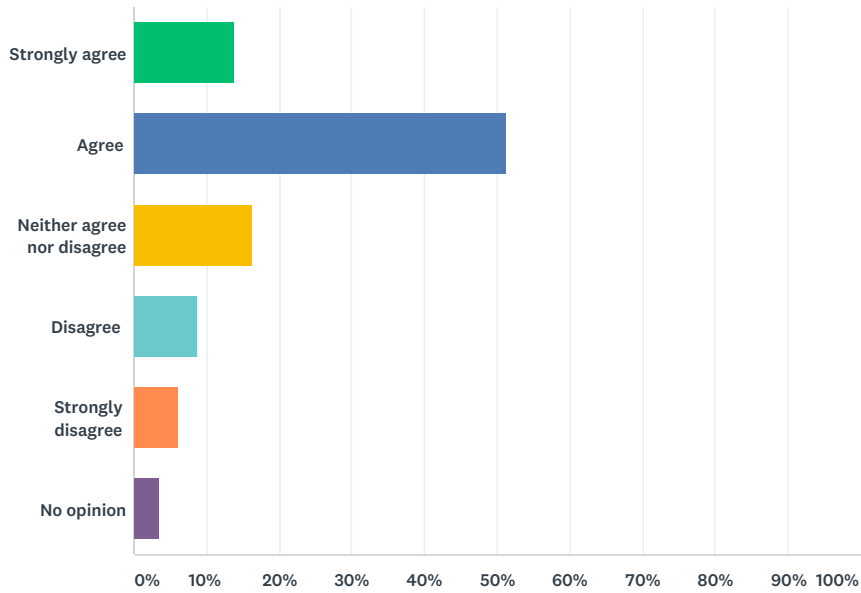

Q14 Town Library expansion should be incorporated into overall growth demands for community hub(s)

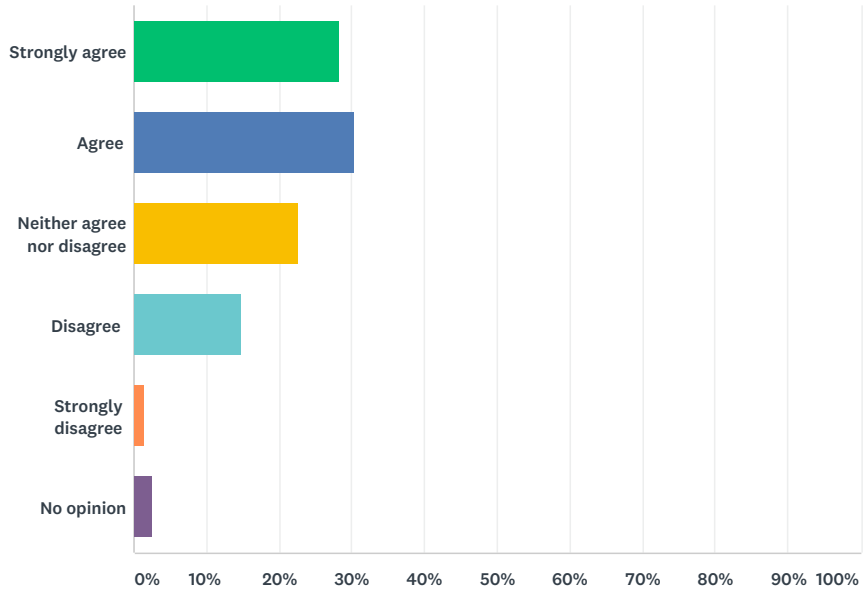

Q15 Health care and a lack of doctors in the area is an issue for me

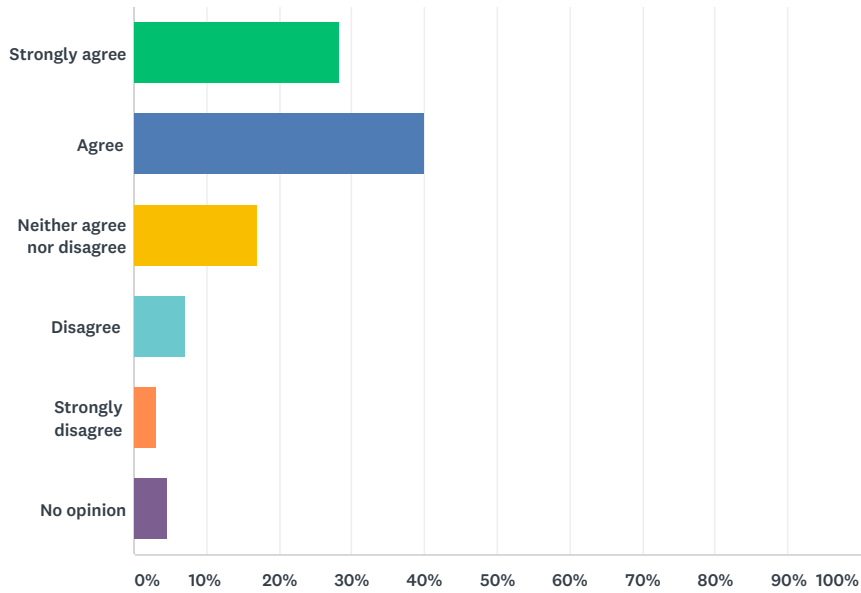
